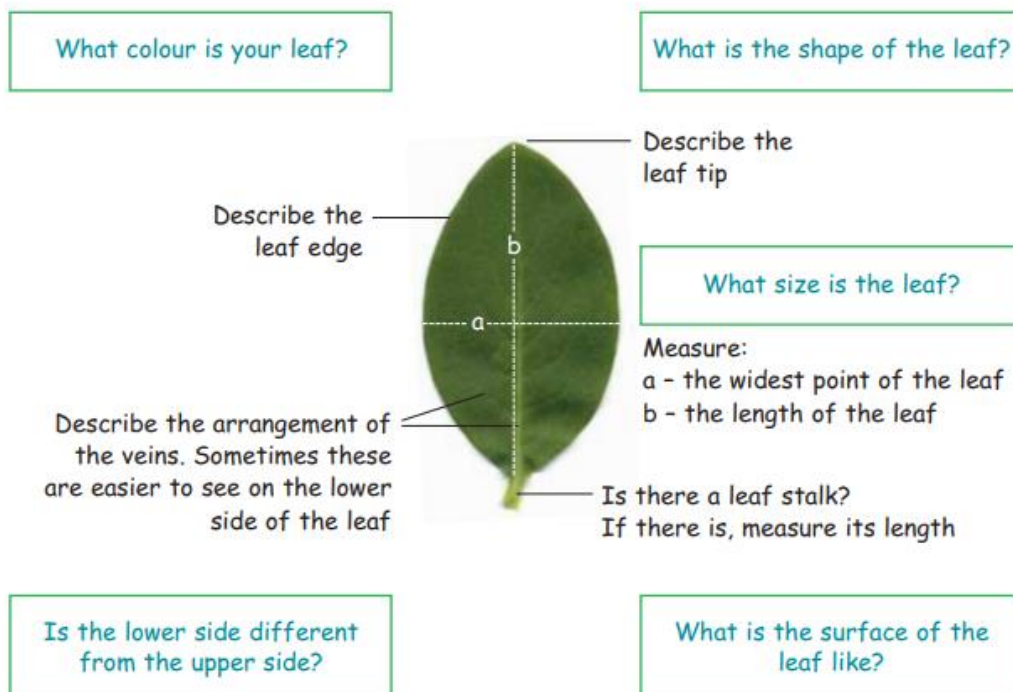
THE IMPACT OF CONSUMERISM ON OUR ENVIRONMENT

In this walk you will know some typical plants of our area, you will learn to recognize them and reflect on the following prompts

1. Which plant does the leaf belong to?
2. What is its scientific name?
3. Describe the shape of the leaf by following the card



Possible words to use in the word bank: Colour... green, brown, yellow, red . Leaf edge: smooth, toothed, wavy, prickly. Leaf surface: smooth, rough, wrinkly dull, glossy hairy, furry, not hairy. Leaf tip: pointed, rounded . Leaf stalk present, absent . Veins: one main vein with branches several veins starting from the bottom of the leaf and coming together again at the tip several main veins spreading out from the bottom of the leaf
